Overview

Encouraging employees to commute using eco-friendly modes of transportation is a key initiative at ETL, aimed at decreasing traffic congestion caused by single-occupancy vehicles. The Green Travel Scheme, initiated in 2022, promotes active travel, car sharing and the use of public transportation. Various programs and incentives are in place to facilitate this shift, including reward opportunities for participants.

This report provides a comparison of the performance between FY23 and FY24, announces the overall champions for FY24, and presents the scheme details for FY25.














FY24 has seen a record number of employees joining our Green Travel Scheme, with 40 staff participating across the year compared with 33 staff in FY23.

There has also been a 61% increase in the number of journeys recorded across FY24 compared with FY23
